ROUND DANCE LESSONS RETURN TO TERRE HAUTE

We found out the Lafayette club was giving round dance lessons, too, starting a week or 2 later, teaching waltz. We jumped at the chance to take that class, too, participating in two classes at the same time,.... One for two-step and the other for waltz. We've not stopped since. Our first two classes were with Linda Brown and Shirley Heiny. When lessons weren't available near us, we started driving to Terre Haute for lessons with Katie & Gene Hawkins. Even now, we continue to take lessons with Jan & Cal Smith. After a while, I had the opportunity to try cueing.... And found it was fun! So, that began our new career. We taught our first class not long after that in the fall of 2008.

We do enjoy dancing and want to share that joy with everyone! We noticed the need for classes in Terre Haute, so we arranged to bring them to the area.

Beginning January 13, 2014 and continuing weekly, round dance classes in Terre Haute to be held at:

Vigo County Fair Grounds (same location as Swinging Mates square dance lessons)

2:30-4:00 GROUP SESSION Phase 2-3

6:30-8:00 GROUP SESSION New dancer's class

Throughout the day, we will give private lessons for our current students.

Cost of lessons is \$12 a couple per lesson, \$6 for singles to cover rent and travel expenses, etc.

We plan to teach waltz in the New Dancers class with possibly adding some two-step before we finish up the series of lessons. We'll be looking at the phase 2-3 dancer's skills to determine how we can help most, maybe beginning with cha cha. We are excited about starting these classes and look forward to seeing everyone there
